Eligibility

- a. Be a citizen of one of the 5 designated Central Asian countries*
 - * Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan
- b. Be enrolled in the second year and above as an undergraduate student at one of the 5 designated Central Asian countries
- c. Be fluent in English
- d. Be mentally and physically healthy
- e. Have the ability and willingness to adapt to Korean culture and life in Korea

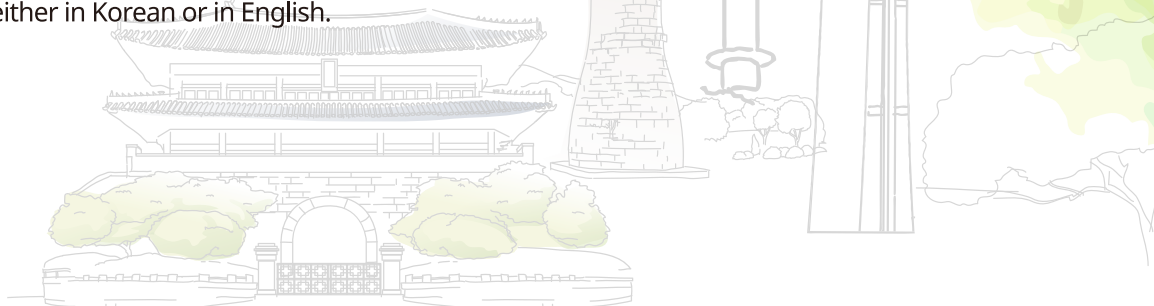

b. How to Apply

- ① Choose one of the 3 designated Korean universities according to your major. You can choose only one of the three universities for your application. You are not allowed to apply to more than one university. Multiple applications will be excluded during the final selection process.
- ② Submit required documents to the chosen application office by e-mail.
- ③ If you pass the document screening, you will be invited for an interview from your application office. Interviews will be conducted by either Skype or phone.

d. Required Documents

- ① Completed Application Form
 - ② Self-Introduction and Research Plan
 - ③ A Letter of Recommendation from an Academic Source
 - ④ A Copy of the Passport Information Page
 - ⑤ Proof of Enrollment from Currently Enrolled University
 - ⑥ Original Sealed Transcript from Currently Enrolled University
- ※ Note : Additional documents may be required from the university you apply to. For documents ①, ② and ③, you should use the provided template. All application documents must be written either in Korean or in English.



Benefits

NIIED and/or the training institutions will be responsible for round trip air ticket, room and board during the duration of the program, and traveler's insurance.

Activities	Contents
Orientation	Introduction to the overall program
Lectures	Specific field of study, Korean language, History and culture, leadership program
